What is biodiversity offsetting?




- Standard framework for assessing impacts of projects at all stages of the mitigation hierarchy
- A way of securing compensation for the longterm if significant harm cannot be avoided
- Allows third-parties to provide compensation potentially a strategic way to achieve net gain




- Can do more for the environment




